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During these first weeks of school, the children and teachers have been having a wonderful time playing and learning together. outdoors play time with a great variety of our preschool toys and activities. The children are becoming socialized to being members of a group in preparation for the coming school years beyond preschool!

Recent September/October Circle Time Themes: Apples, Colors & Shapes, Transportation, Fall is Here!

Recent Bible Learning: Adam and Eve in the Garden (good choices versus bad choices)-Genesis 3, Noah's Big Boat-Genesis 6:5-9:16, Joshua and the Big Wall-Joshua 6: 1-20, Zacchaeus-Luke 19.

Projects: The MWF class took an apple "taste test" (Granny Smith was the winner), used apples to make prints on

the letter A, glued miscellaneous blue items on the letter B, made paper airplanes, made a Fall yarn tree, created scratch art leaf "fairies", and had a leaf hunt in the play yard!

The TTH class painted adorable "photo-frame" apples to hang on our tree in the classroom, stamped with colorful shapes, and made a Fall tree by painting fall colors with a foil ball. Both classes made yummy applesauce (that was eaten at snack), experimented with mixing primary water colors, created a handprint rainbow, glued a train track letter T, built a colorful craft stick raft, and stamped fall colors on paper leaves with Legos.
