

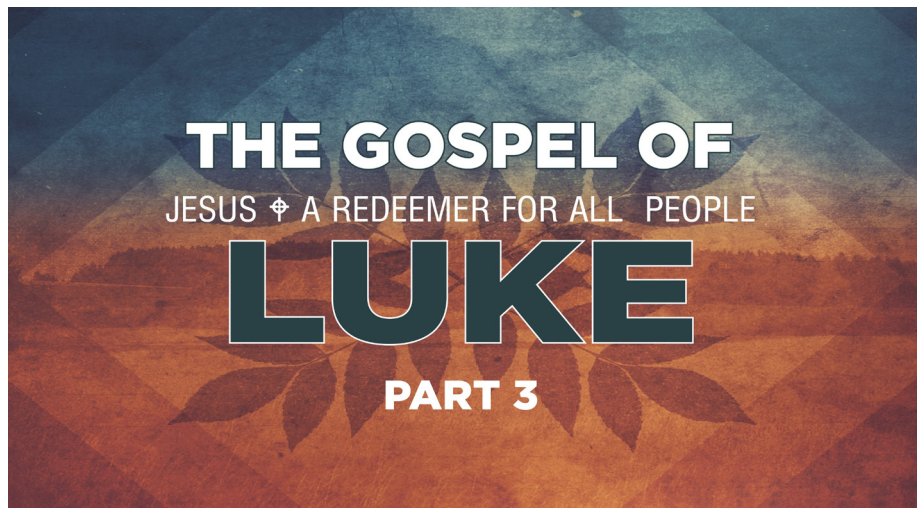


### Luke Part 3

Studying the parallels will expand your knowledge of the scriptures and give you insights beyond what you would otherwise get.

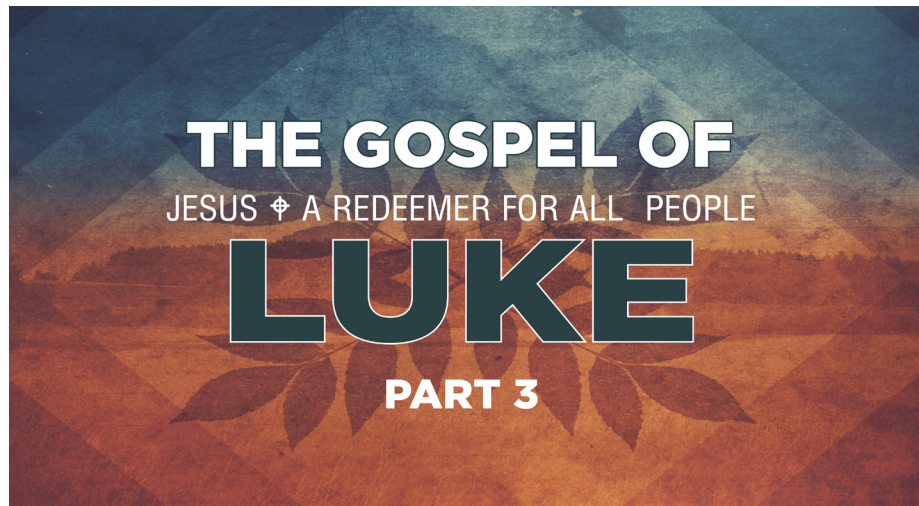


**Luke 11:1-4**

Is it necessary to pray the Lord's Prayer?



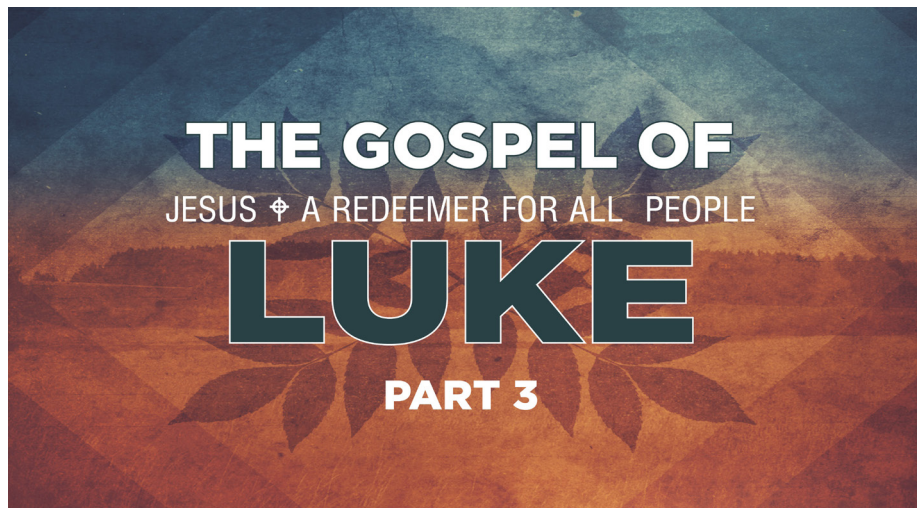
**Luke 11:5-13**

What should we ask the Lord for?

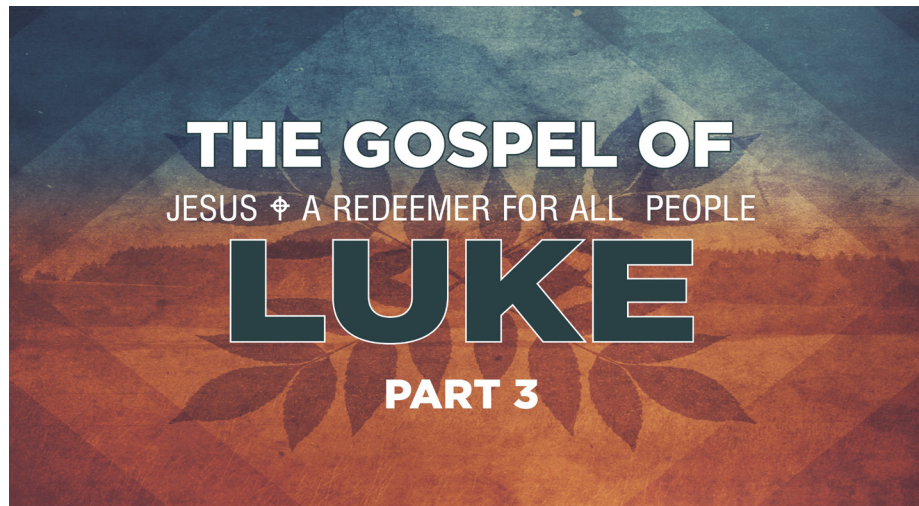
Does He always give what we ask for?

**Seeking a Sign**

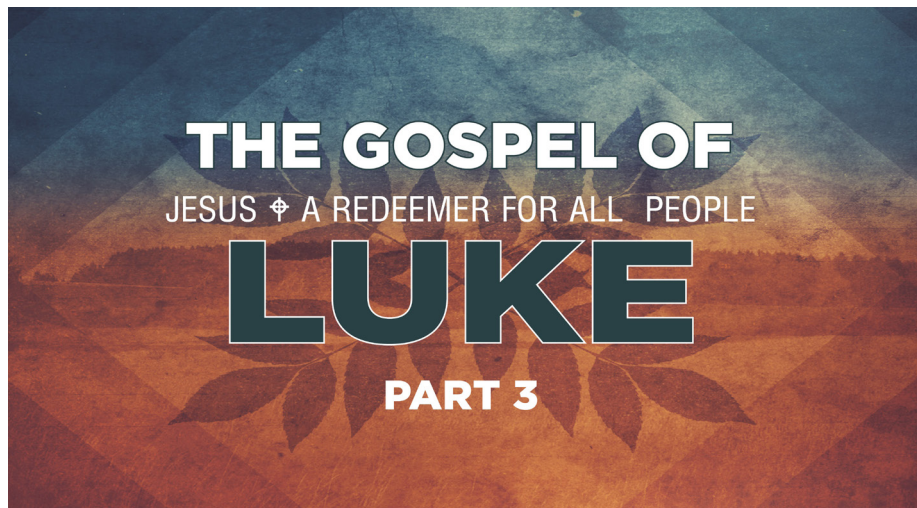
**DISCUSSION**

Are there times when this is relevant?





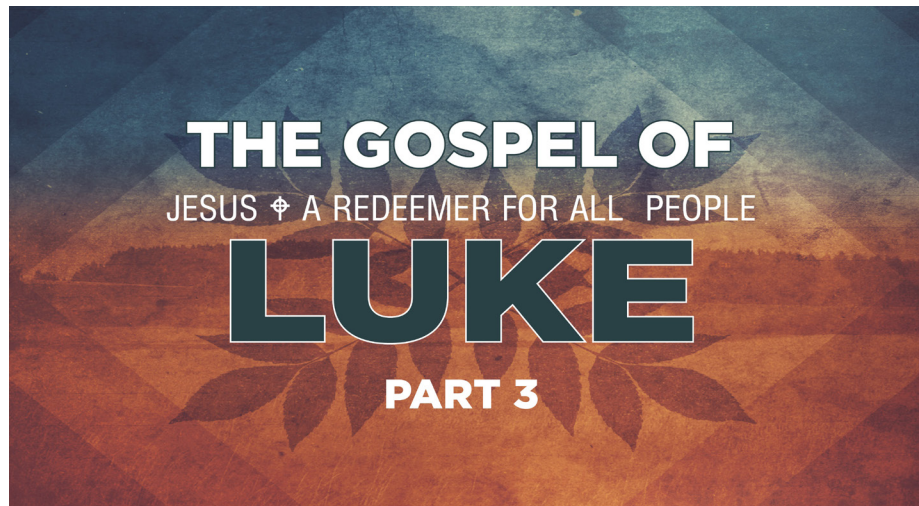
**Luke 11:37-54**

What areas are we missing?

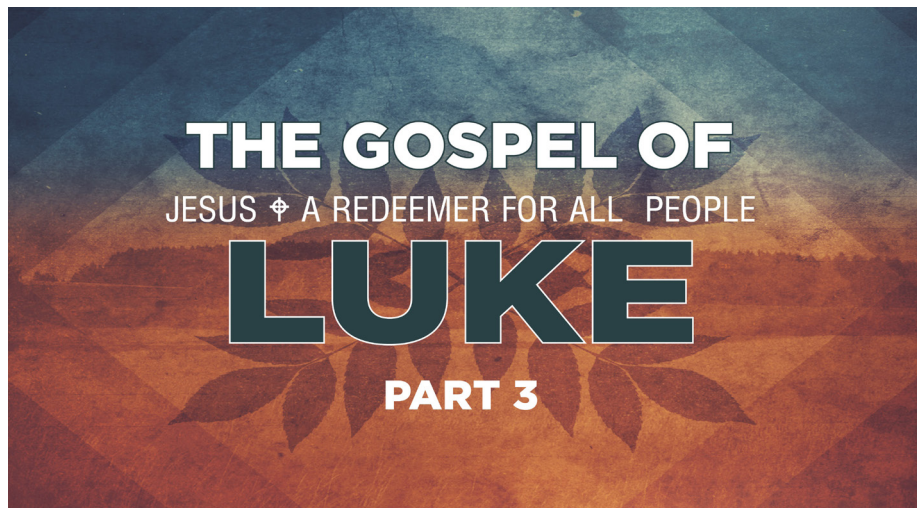


**Luke 12:1-7**

Who are to fear the Lord?

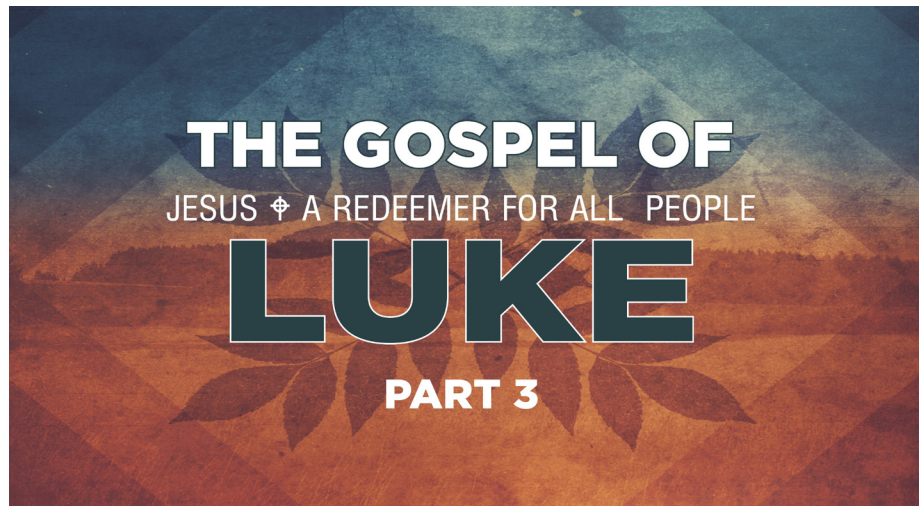


**Luke 12:8-12**

What is blasphemy of the Holy Spirit





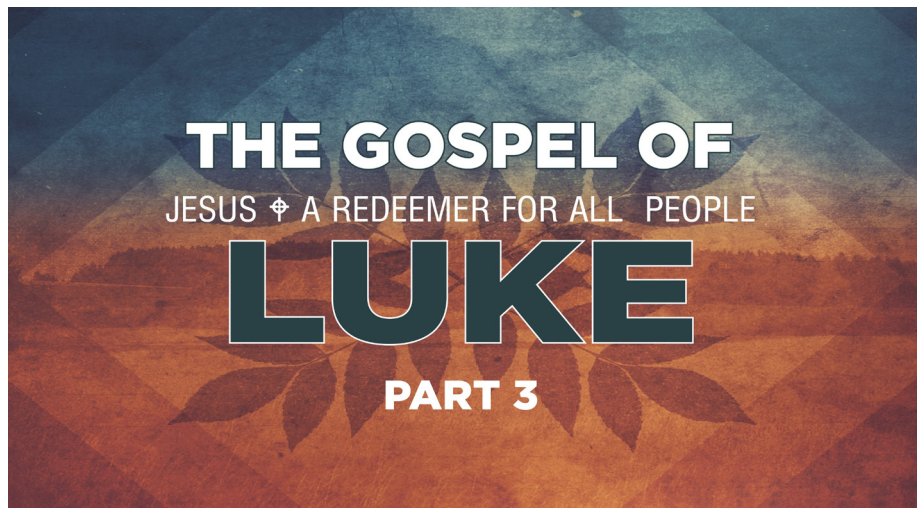
**Luke 12:13-21**

Is it wrong to save and store up for the future?



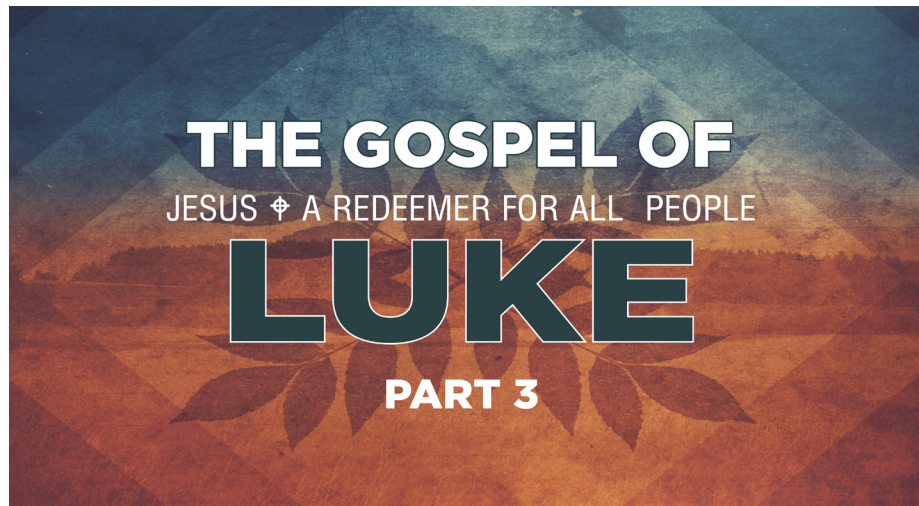
**Luke 12:22-34**

Discuss anxiety, how does it impact your life and those in your Life Group?

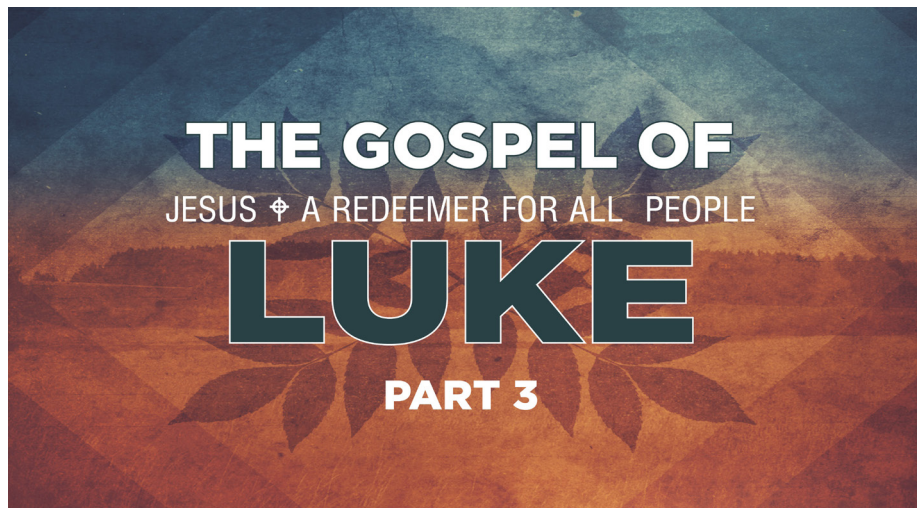


**Luke 12:35-48**

What does it mean to be prepared for the return of the Master?



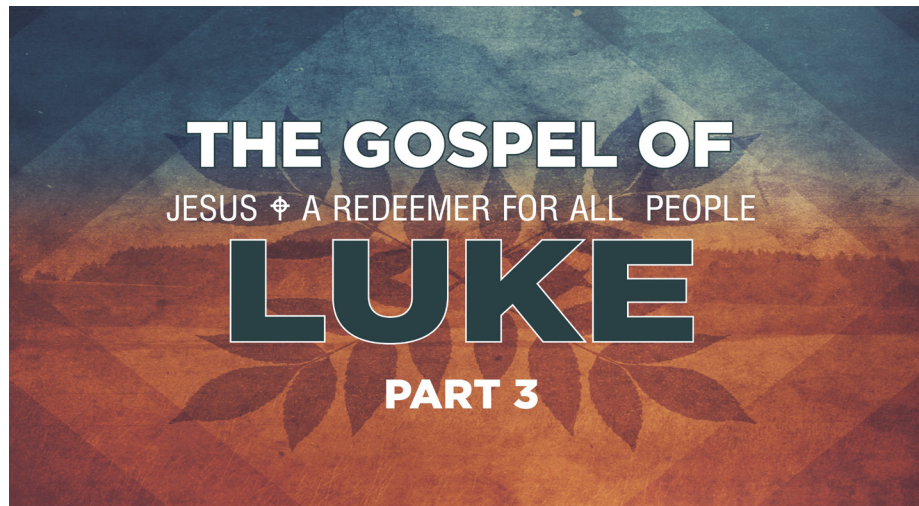
**Luke 12:49-59**

How is the debt to be paid?



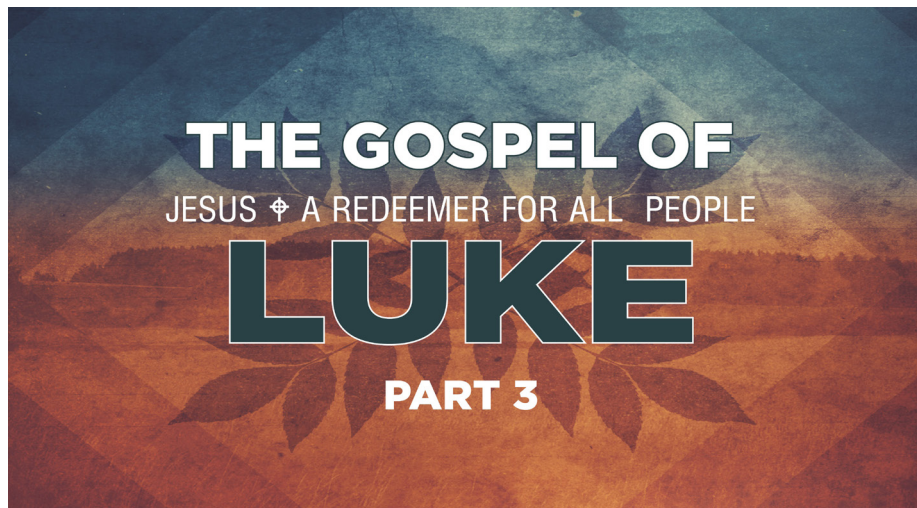
**Luke 13:1-9**

What does repentance look like?





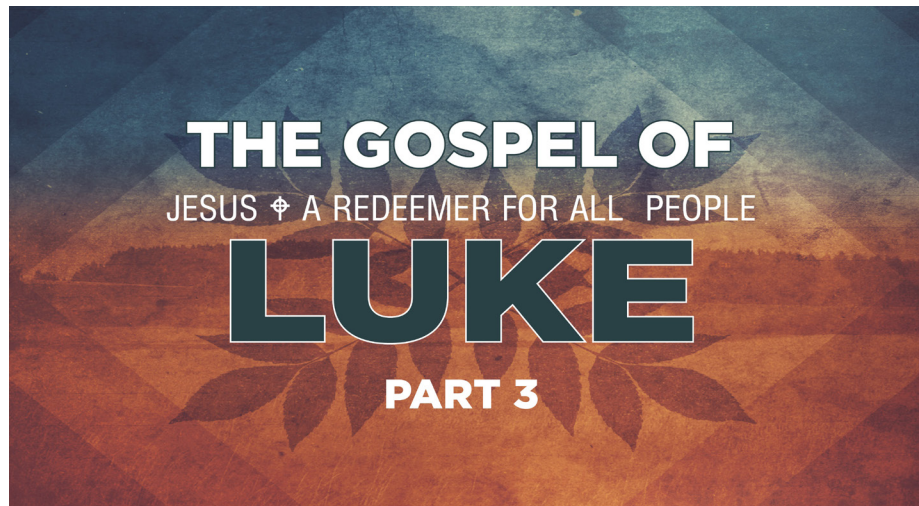
**Luke 13:10-21**

Discuss the imagery of the Kingdom of Heaven.



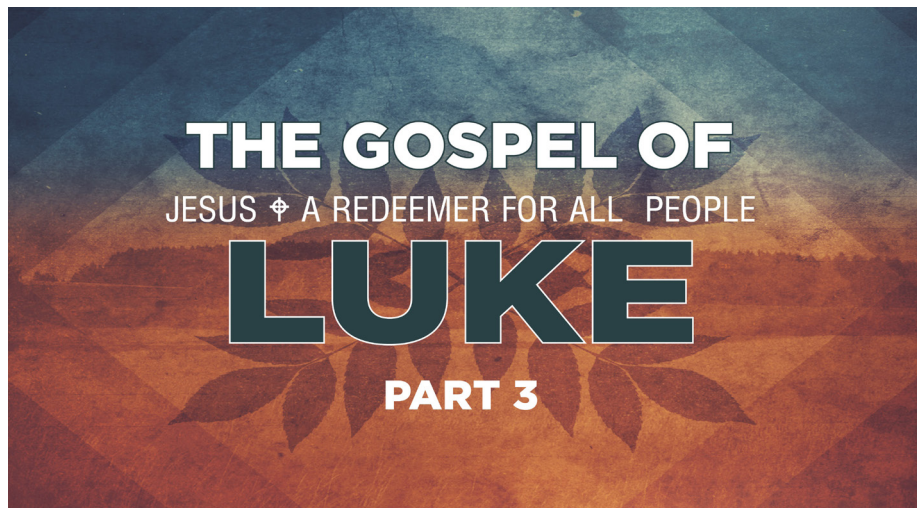
**Luke 13:22-25**

Who will recline at the table?

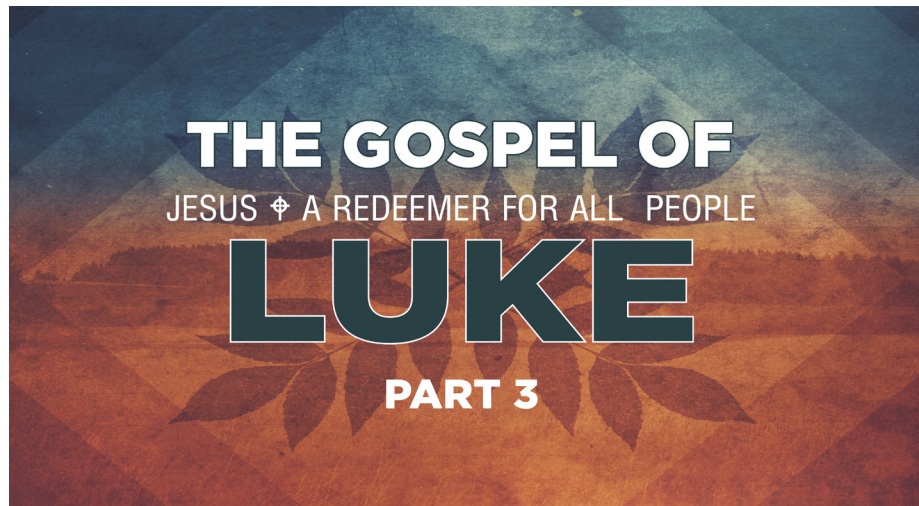


**Luke 14:1-14**

How does it speak to our priorities?



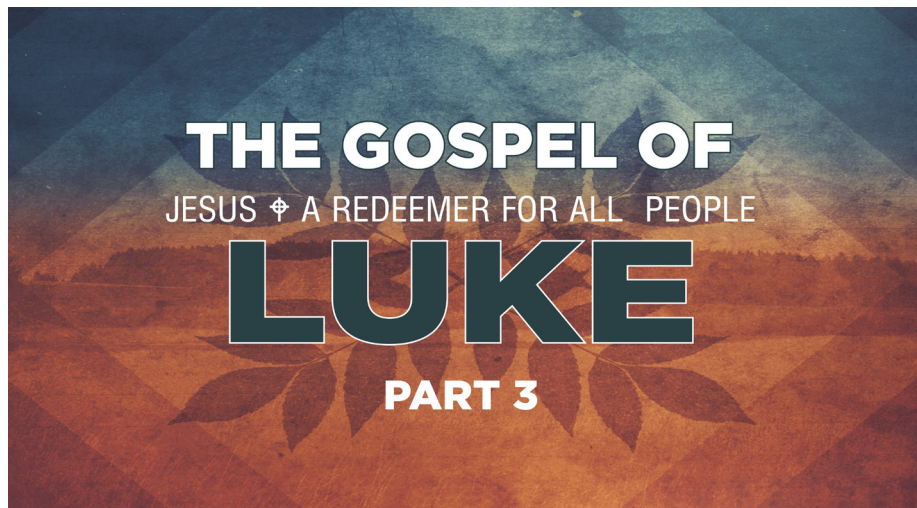
**Luke 14:15–24**

**The Cost of Discipleship**

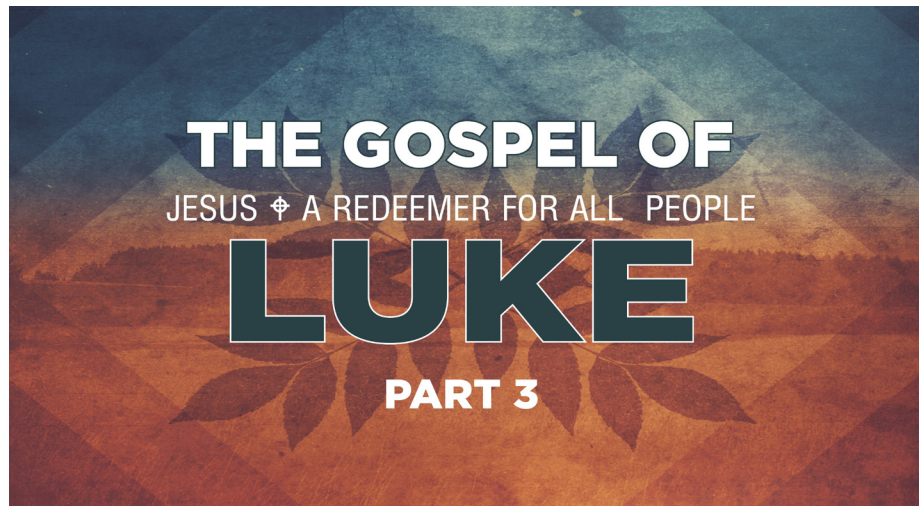
**DISCUSSION**

Discuss the areas of your lives where a price has been paid.



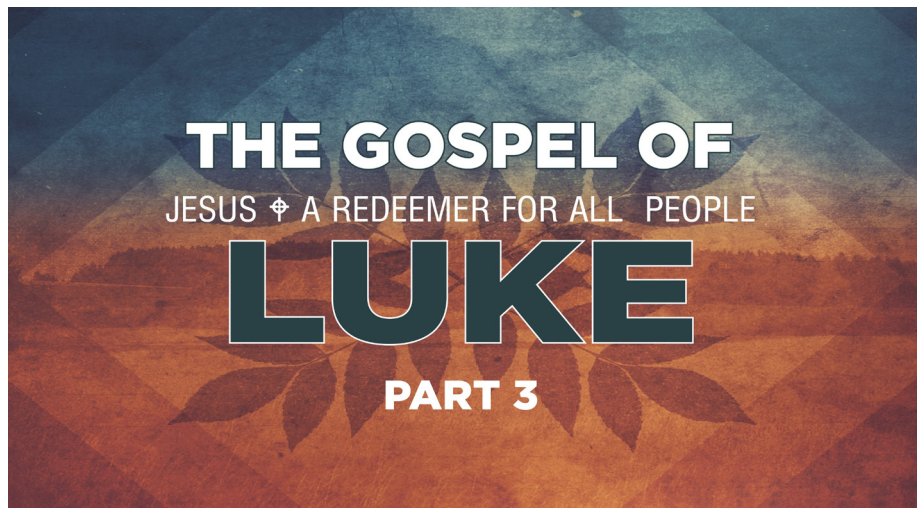


**Luke 15:1-10**

What is the main focus of the passage?



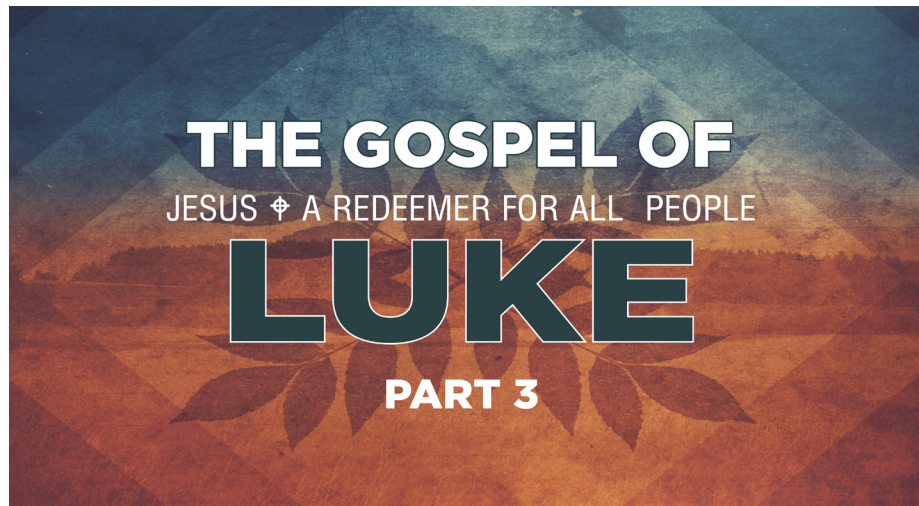
**Luke 15:11-32**

Discuss the state of the other two sons: where they were right, and where they went wrong.



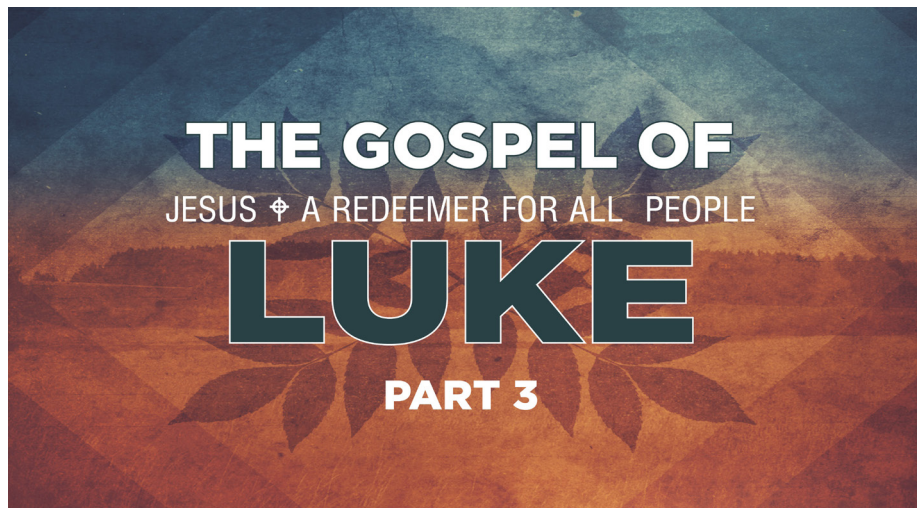
**Luke 16:1-13**

What is the overall thrust of the message of this passage?



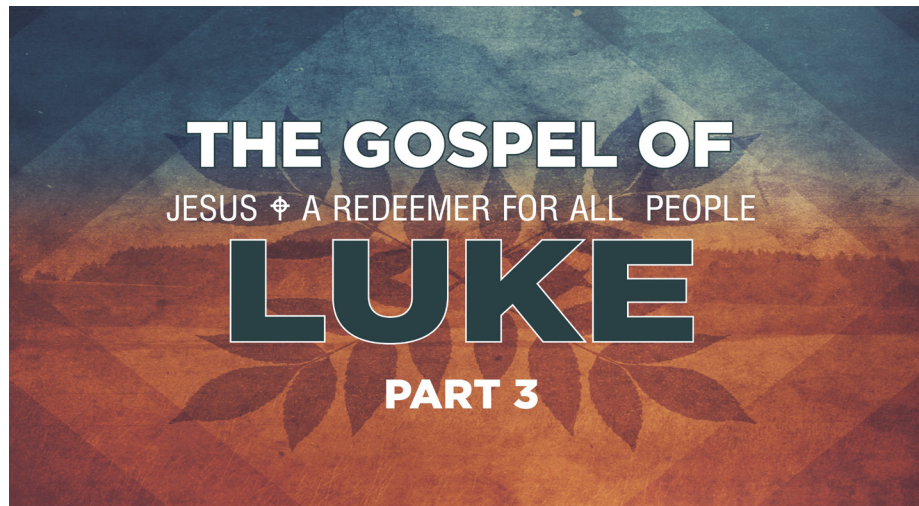
**Luke 16:14-18**

Discuss this passage on divorce.

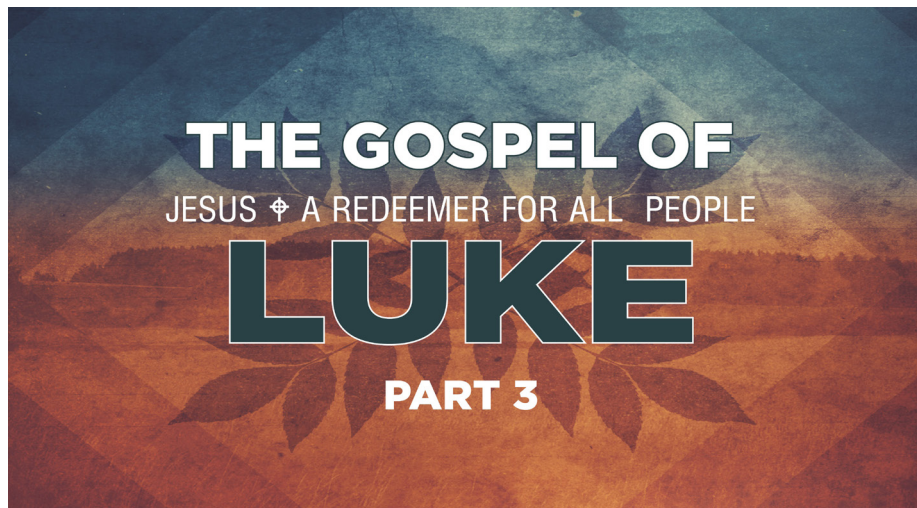


**Luke 16:19-31**

Where does the responsibility lie?

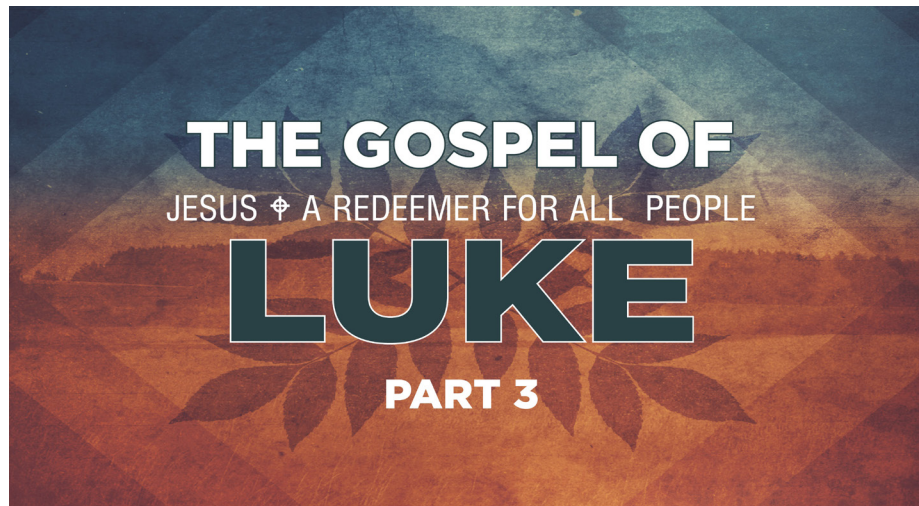




**Luke 17:1-10**

What is the main teaching point of the unworthy servant.

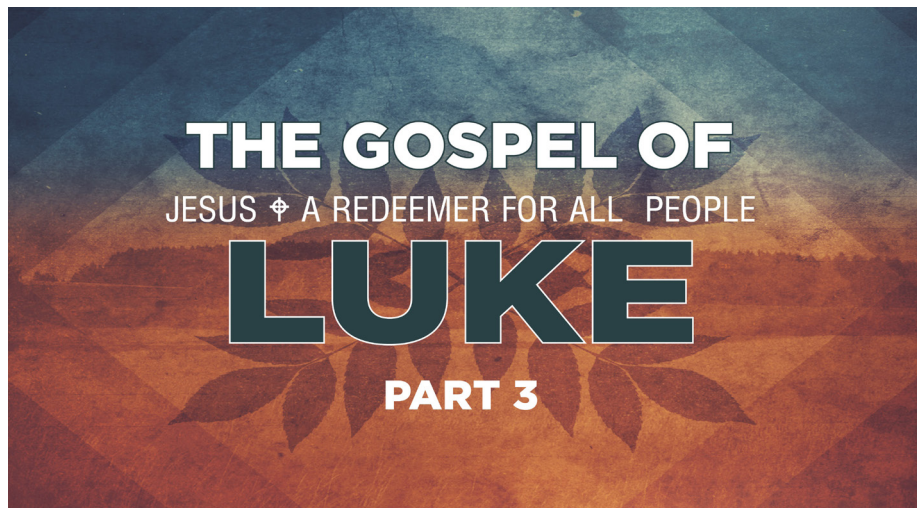


**Luke 17:11-19**

**DISCUSSION**

What is the main message here?

What is the importance of the individual being a Samaritan?



**Luke 17:20-37**  
**The Kingdom Come**

**DISCUSSION**

How will the Kingdom of God appear?

Discuss the day when the Son of Man will be revealed. When will that be?

Have fun discussing eschatology, see how others see the end times unrolling.
